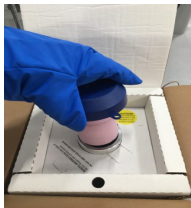


Section A Verifying Charge and Removing LN2 Sock

Step A1



Wearing safety gloves, remove the vapor plug. Place plug to one side. **DO NOT** discard plug.

If the dry shipper does not emit nitrogen vapor, please contact customer service immediately, by calling (949) 470-2305 or emailing cs@cryoport.com.



For International or Extended use orders only, a white sock string might be present. Please follow step A2.

When no string is present, please skip ahead to step A3.

Step A2



Pull white string and remove socks.



Discard socks.



CAUTION!

There may be residual LN2 in the socks. Hold socks over opening of the dewar to allow liquid to drip back into dewar. Use caution when transporting socks to garbage to prevent contact with liquid.

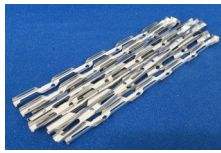
Step A3



Replace the vapor plug until you are ready to load your samples into the dry shipper.

Section B Packaging the Specimen

Step 1



Load samples to be shipped into canes, boxes or plastic goblets. Be sure to replace lid on plastic goblet.

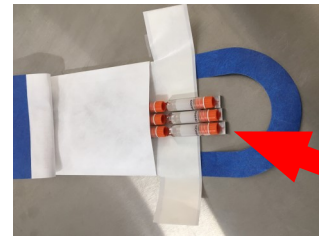
Step 2

Use Safepak™ bag for all samples.

Note: The absorbent material is now incorporated into the bag!

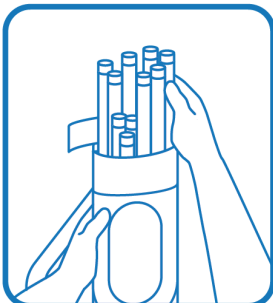


Tyvek bag holds the following quantities:
Canes: 15 (5 clip canes) for a total of 75 - 2ml cryovials
Goblets: 2
Boxes: 2 (30 ct of 2ml vials)

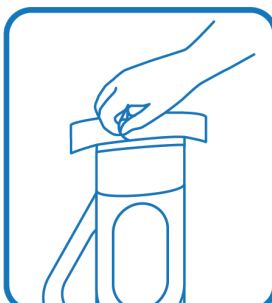


Place specimens inside the Safepak™ and push them all the way down to the inside bottom of the bag.

Section C Loading & Sealing the Saftpak™



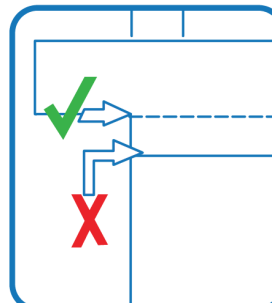
Fold Handle down to access pouch opening. Insert canes into opening. Push canes completely into bag.



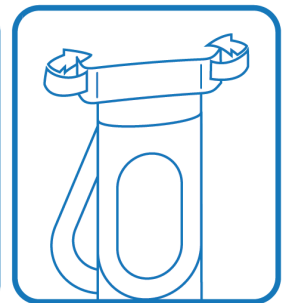
Peel off the adhesive strip cover.



Remove cover from adhesive strip, fold along crease (Detail A) and seal bag by applying pressure.



Detail A



Move back handle away from pouch edge, fold tabs around and seal with pressure.

Section C Loading Samples for Shipment

Step 1



Remove shippo plug.

Step 2



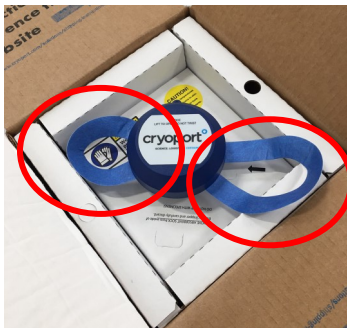
Lower Tyvek bag into shippo and gently push down with gloved hand if necessary.

Step 3



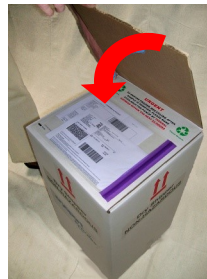
Replace shippo plug. Shippo plug can be used to help insert Tyvek bag down into storage well.

Step 4



Assure blue straps are left on outside of the shippo plug!

Step 5



- Close flaps making sure to have flap "A" showing on the outside of the white carton.
- For International shipments: REMOVE AND SIGN ALL FOUR (4) COPIES OF COMMERCIAL INVOICES.
- Place all four (4) signed copies of Commercial Invoices back inside shipping envelope on Flap "A" behind Air Waybill.

Section D

Ship



Seal top of white carton with packaging tape making sure to have flap "A" showing on the outside of the white carton.

For those shipments containing regulated dangerous goods/hazardous materials, the shipper is responsible for correctly preparing the shipment according to the current International Air Transport Association (IATA) and International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) dangerous goods regulations. This includes correct identification, classification, packaging, dangerous goods markings and labeling as well as completion of all pertinent and required documentation. The shipper is the customer who is preparing the shipment at each leg in the transportation of the dry dewar packaging.
